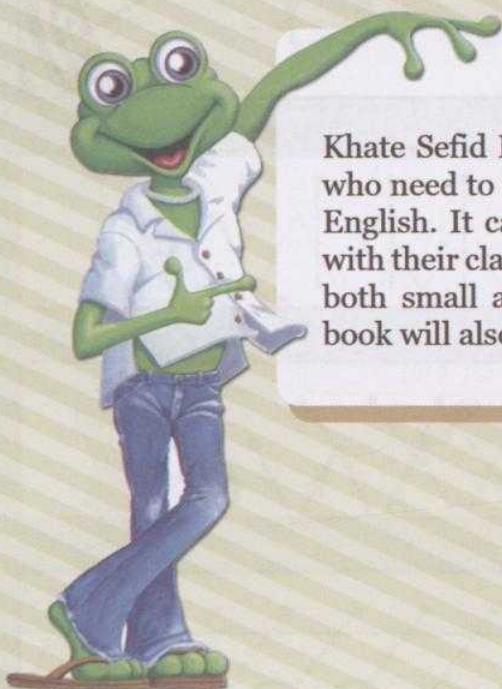

INTRODUCTION

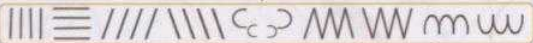


Khate Sefid English Handwriting (Book 1) is for children who need to learn how to write the letters and numbers in English. It can be used by parents at home and teachers with their classes. Children will learn to recognize and form both small and capital letters and number shapes. This book will also help them learn new vocabulary.

TEACHING TIPS



When children are learning to write, make sure they are sitting in a good position and holding their pen or pencil correctly. The book also should be in a good position for left-handed and right-handed children. Check that the letters are being formed correctly. Directional arrows are given for each letter and number.

Before you begin to use this book, draw some of the patterns like this  on the board for your children to copy. See how they are holding the pen or pencil while copying the patterns. Show the children how to trace the shape of both small and capital letters. Explain that they must follow the numbered arrows.

Let the children copy the letters. Watch them carefully to make sure that they follow the shape of the letters correctly. After teaching every four letters, have the children do the exercises.
