His honourable name is 'Alī and his famous nickname is Abū al-Ḥasan and his well-known Titles of Honour are:

- Ridā (the pleased one)
- Gharīb al-Ghurabā (the most strange of strangers)
- Mu'īn al-Du'afā (the helper of the weak)
