

English Basics for University

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There are various textbooks available for academic purposes for both general and special English. **English Basics for University** fulfills the requirements of the general English course at university. The passages are designed and selected to be attractive to the younger generation especially university and college students. Meanwhile, innovative techniques are employed to challenge the reader's mind in recalling the newly introduced words. This can be regarded as a major merit of this book compared with similar textbooks.

A main concern in general English textbooks for academic purposes is the way structure is taught in the grammar section. **English Basics for University** follows an orderly sequence to present grammatical points from the most fundamental to the apparently complex issues. What may be particularly interesting are the reviews in multiple-choice form that can prepare the reader for academic tests of English. This book, as suggested by the authors, is most appropriate for the so-called Pre- university English course which is a pre-requisite course for the lower-intermediate students at university. In its current status, this book can be best recommended as the textbook for this course at higher education institutes.

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
