Eric Arthur Blair (25 June 1903 – 21 January 1950), better known by his pen name George Orwell, was an English novelist, essayist, journalist, and critic. His work is marked by lucid prose, awareness of social injustice, opposition to totalitarianism, and outspoken support of democratic socialism.

wrote literary criticism, poetry, and polemical journalism. He is best known for allegorical novella Animal Farm (19 (5) and the dystopian novel Nineteen Eighty-Four (194.) It is nonfiction works, including The Road to Vi an Pier (1937), documenting his experience of work, g class life in the north of England, and Homag 1 Catalonia (1938), an account of his experiences in the Canish Civil War, are widely acclaimed. re his essays on as literature, language, and culture. In 2008, The Times ranked him second on a list of the 50 greatest British writers since 1945".

Orven's ork continues to influence popular and political ulture, and the term Orwellian – descriptive of totalia ian or authoritarian social practices – has entered the language together with many of his neologisms, including Big Brother, Thought Police, Room 101, memory hole, newspeak, doublethink, paroles, unperson, and thought crime.

Animal Farm is an allegorical novella by George Orwell, first published in England on 17 August 1945. According to Orwell, the book reflects events leading up to the Russian Revolution of 1917 and then on into the Stalinist era of the Soviet Union, Orwell, a democratic socialist, was a critic of Joseph Stalin and hostile to Moscow-directed Stalinism, an attitude that was critically shaped by his experience during the Spanish Civil War. The Soviet Union, he believed had become a brutal dictatorship, built upon a vicot, ersonality and enforced by a reign of terror. In letter 's Yvonne Davet, Orwell described Animal Faim as a satirical tale against Stalin ("un contesatiriquecon reScanne"), and in his essay "Why I Write" (1946), write that Animal Farm was the first book in which he ried, ...th full consciousness of what he was doing, "to it e political purpose and artistic purpose into one who 'e".
