## Introduction

Basics in English Reading and Grammar (BERG) is a collection of various reading passages intended to develop reading skills at elementary and pre-intermediate level. The first eight units are designed as a preparatory course and the remaining twelve units as a general course for university students. It can also be used as a self-study source for students and adults who want to strengthen their reading skills and to expand their English vocabulary.

Each unit starts with introducing the new words. Before students read the passages, pre-reading questions concerning the major theme of the passage are offered.
