The Persian Empire was humane and equal in nature and was the first ver Federal system in the world. Each State had absolute internal utonomy to do as they pleased with their own internal affairs. It was a rimitive form of Federalism in comparison to today's Federal systems, but magine back then when everyone including China, Egypt, Greece and come practiced slavery and colonialism, Persia granted internal autonomy all states. All states had control over their affairs, their educations ystem, local languages and even their own military forces.

Cyrus was distinguished no less as statesman than as a soldier. He tatesmanship came out particularly in his treatments of new concurred eeople. By pursuing a policy of generosity, instead of repression, and by avoring the local religion, he was able to make his new subjects his enthusiastic supporters.

During his twenty-nine year reign, Cyrus freezest states of his time, including the leasar Empire, the Lydian Empire, and the Neo-Babylonian Empire, avonce as nation, Cyrus left a asting legacy on Jewish religion (through his Edict of Restoration), politics, and military strategy, as tell as on both Eastern and Western sivilization.
