INTRODUCTION TO THE SECOND VOLUME OF *UŞŪLAL KĀFĪ*

Our infinite thanks are due to the Beneficient Allah that after a painful delay that took place in the translation and publication of an-other part of $Us)\bar{u}l$ from the book of $al-K\tilde{a}f\tilde{i}$, now, by the Grace of the Almighty Allah, this Organization has seriously decided to expedite the work of translation and publication of the second volume of the book.

Though we lost the services of most of the scholarly group who worked in the translation of the first volume, nevertheless, we have been able – by the Help of the Almighty Allāh – to acquire valuable resources with renewed scholarly control. This has given us the initiative for rapid progress of the work.

The question of morality is one of the most important issues of the day. Whenever forces of materialism indulge in excesses, the necessity to work in the field of morality becomes more obvious and urgent. Materialism leades to oppression, humiliation, degradation of human character and increases social insecurity. Fortunately, this second volume of $Us)\bar{u}l$ al-Kāfī generally deals with morality and a part of it deals with supplication and the Holy Qur'ãn.
