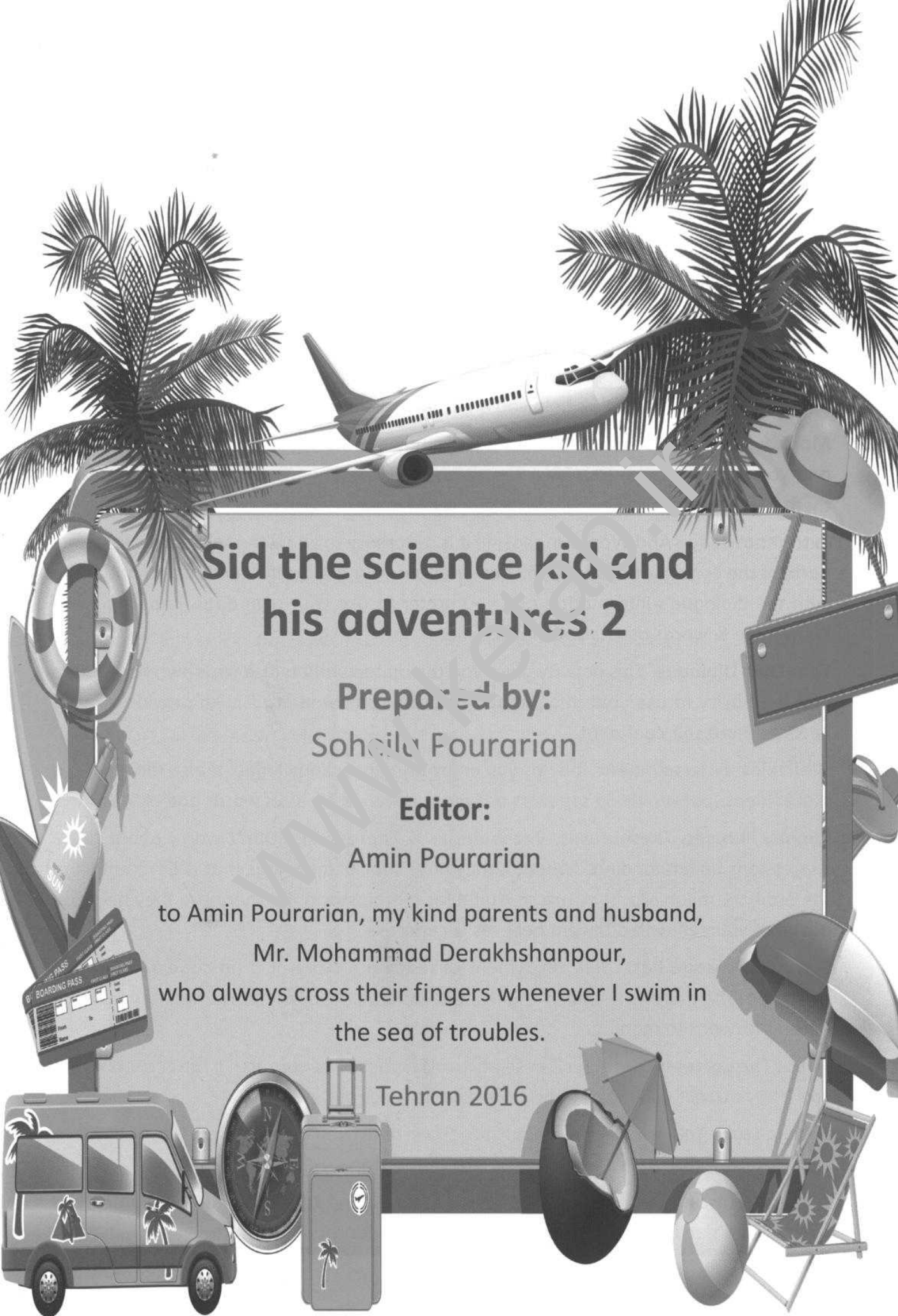

Enjoy your dialogue, pair work and group work In all units there is a communication task for you to do with a partner or group. Sometimes you will look at photos and decide on a story for the photos. At other times you will share information with a partner or partners. Related communication tasks are on different pages. Sid the science kid and different cartoon characters help you enjoy your dialogue.

Magnifying Glass Words In this part, you study the dialogue's new words' definitions and you have to make your own sentences with those words to know the usage of them. Due to learn the new words better, try to make sentences as much as possible.

Extra Knowledge And Words In real life it is necessary to know the substitutes for some parts of the conversations to speak better about your life. Sometimes you do not agree with the dialogue's information and you prefer to use your own data. Knowing extra knowledge & words assists you in this issue.

Your Own Dialogue This activity gives you the opportunity to use your own knowledge and the ability to use your imagination to produce new ideas. It also provides you to become more self-confident.

Whizzkids' Entertainment It helps you enjoy using new knowledge. It also makes you a more fluent speaker. Good speakers use many different kinds of words and expressions.

Idioms, Phrases, These phrases, vocabularies & Expressions Don't worry about these expressions understanding. Although they have special meanings that is different from the ordinary meanings, they are so useful for a brainstorm. Furthermore they help you acquaint yourself with different believes & cultures.

Story Or Passage Part Your enjoyment of reading a story or a passage will develop over time. The more you read in English, the easier it will become. You will find yourself looking forward to reading.
