INTRODUCTION

It has not been so long since the Islamic University College, Ghana (IUCG) was established by the Iranians in the capital of Ghana, Accra, to contribute to the development of this country. It might be too soon to give the full evaluation of this wonderful institute; the achievement already chalked can only be described as outstanding.

Within these years many students graduated from the institute and many of them taken on jobs that enable them play important roles in their communities. The IUCG has, thus, been able to bring out the high potential which exists within these very hard-working and brilliant students.

I have had the honour to be with some of them for four years. Some of my past students have done M. Phil at Legon and are preparing for their P.hD while some are lecturers.

In the first semester of the academic year 2008/2009, I had a course with the Level 400 students entitled "*Study of*

Hadith".

Getting inspiration from the tradition from the Holy Prophet of Islam (p.b.u.h) which emphasises the learning and memorising of forty Hadiths, I included forty Hadiths in the course outline and taught the students.
