It includes twenty- e lesso is. The core of each lesson is a text whose clip appearing ompact disc, CD, accompanying the book. A clip is a bat Im lasting for 1 to 5 minutes whose textual script apport in each esson. After listening to each script, listeners are red ed to answer the listening comprehension questions following the script. The difficult words in the text script of each look are presented after each lesson in the form of a Vocabula v is Each difficult word appears in the form of a boldfaced enter is its pronunciation, part of speech, definition, synonym, Perial et valent, and a sentence or more to exemplify its meaning. There also exercises following each script to reinforce the ling information and schematic content of the lessons. The exercise deal with grammar and lexicon. The difficult words are tested in the form of multiple-choice test items, filling-in-the-blank, and matching exercises. At the end of each lesson, there is a section called Did You Know...? This part explains in brief the concepts and expressions existing in each script whose purpose is to provide further background information for the listeners to understand the script better. Naturally, English learners' dictionaries do not usually provide

information regarding such concepts and expressions. For example, a brief explanation of the expression The Indian Independent Movement is provided at the end of Lesson One. In Lesson Two, the expressions piki, hopi, and black mesa are described to provide listeners with more information so that the understanding of the passage is enhanced. One of the major advantages of the book is that each script begins with a picture which is intended to depict the content of the text and esta lish or activate the listeners' visual memory. There are also small pic res throughout the book to follow the same end. The other advange is that there is a Review Section after every five Asso dealing with grammar and lexicon present in the lessons. However, the book is not the only one of its type; instead, it is unique the market since, as far as we know, there is no such a book a lable here in Iran to deal with listening audio-visually. It is a occuprehensive in that it tries its best to analyze the script to a tend of lexicon, grammar, and background content. No this book would bear shortcomings because it was 'h outhors' first experience in writing such a necessary book in the Iranian EFL context. The authors, therefore, take the resp. usibility for its shortcomings which can be removed with the same comments which the dear listeners and readers of the oo. Ill give us. Last but not least, we are much grateful to Pezae, the Head of the Arad Publication, without whose we not ration and professional assistance, this book would not hav been ublished.
