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Preface

Practical Reading and Writing is a book for the students who want to learn English as a second language. It contains materials for intermediate level. The book is recommended for university students and also for high school students to expand their knowledge of vocabulary and strengthen their reading skills.

It consists of twenty units. Each unit contains seven parts:

1. Warm up (pre-reading questions) 2. Reading passage along with a while reading question that challenges the readers' predicting ability 3. Comprehension (post-reading) questions 4. Recognizing meaning of words, phrases and sentences in the text 5. Word recognition through collocation rules 6. Matching the related phrases or sentences which have been given in two columns 7. Grammar including part of speech and sentence writing.

The purpose of the author is to help students get mastery of reading passages, writing and also speaking.

Both deductive and inductive learning methods have been used in the book. Part one to six in each unit is based on inductive learning. It lets the students read the passage by themselves, and discover the meaning of every individual word, phrase and sentence in order to get the main idea of the text. The passage is not translated for them, and no information about the passage is

given to them either. Only part seven in each unit is based on deductive learning. In this part, practices follow teaching materials.

In the end, I appreciate Mr. Imami that encouraged me to write the book. I also wish the best use of the book for the readers.
