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## Preface

This book has been written for the university students whose major field is other than English. Its main goal is to improve reading comprehension as an important language learning activity. It also provides grammatical points, especially basic sentence structure as an authentic communication process. The book includes various challenging topics such as science, humanities, citizenship issues, technology, computer, accounting, physiology, literature, history, civilization etc.

The book has two sections: Part I, Texts: It presents interesting texts with targeted words which have been highlighted in the text to reinforce their importance in learning.
