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Preface

English for Engineering offers authentic texts for the university students majoring in Electronic and Electrotechnic Engineering. Since tackling and comprehending a reading text is a great need for non-English students, the focus of this book is on reading skill. Despite the presence of so many different reading books, a gap in a proper textbook for ESP and Associate's students was considered; thereupon this textbook has been designed to help the students benefit from authentic texts and simple fundamental grammar points. It can also enhance the students' enjoyment of reading and boost their motivation.

This book consists of twelve lessons and three tests at the end part. Each lesson contains a list of vocabulary and the related definitions, a reading text, and a grammar slice. The list of vocabulary and short definitions which provide the students with a general background are easy-to-use.

The teachers can help their students build and develop vocabulary through context. High-interest reading topics, like Digital Television System, MRI Scan, Memory Devices, Touch Screen Technology, Induction Motor, etc., are selected. Reading texts are followed by comprehension exercises such as True/False, Multiple-choice, and Matching-column items.

Next part of the lesson allocated to grammar slice is really user-friendly; it covers the basics of grammatical structures necessary for non-English students. The grammar slice, mostly, deals with a point repeating in the reading passage; besides guided exercises check the students' understanding.

At the end of the book, three short passages are followed by Multiple-choice items.

We did our best to make understanding ESP English texts easy and tangible for students. Despite our attempts, this book may contain mistakes in some parts. Any comments for better quality will be appreciated in advance.

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
